From the President

In communities like ours, it doesn't take long to see the impact of people helping people.

You see it in volunteers who show up without being asked. In donors who quietly give because they care about the future of their hometowns. In teachers, coaches, nonprofit leaders, and neighbors who continue to invest their time, talents, and resources to make Merrick County a better place to live, work, and raise a family.

That small-town spirit is what drives the work of Merrick Foundation every single day.

Over the past year, we've had the privilege of helping support projects and opportunities across Merrick County that will make a lasting impact for years to come. Together, we awarded \$169,457 in competitive community grants to local organizations and \$169,800 in scholarships to 179 students pursuing their educational goals after high school. From community spaces and youth programs to local nonprofits and educational opportunities, these investments continue to strengthen the places and people that make our county special.

We also welcomed nine new funds this year and received more than \$2.3 million in contributions from individuals, families, businesses, and organizations who believe in giving back close to home. Every gift—large or small—helps create opportunities not only for today, but for future generations as well.

Another big milestone this year was Merrick Foundation receiving Community Foundations National Standards® accreditation, recognizing our commitment to strong stewardship, accountability, and serving our communities with integrity. While we are proud of this achievement, we remain focused on what matters most: helping connect generous people with meaningful causes right here in Merrick County.

As of December 31, 2025, Merrick Foundation's assets grew to more than \$25.8 million. More importantly, those funds represent something much bigger than numbers on paper. They represent generosity, trust, and a shared belief in the future of our communities.

We know the strength of small towns has never been found in one person alone. It's found in neighbors helping neighbors, communities working together, and people choosing to invest in something bigger than themselves.

Thank you for being part of that story. Because of your support, Merrick Foundation can continue connecting people who care with causes that matter—and helping Merrick County thrive for generations to come.

In 2026, Merrick Foundation earned accreditation through Community Foundations National Standards®—the nation's highest standards for philanthropic excellence.

This distinction confirms that Merrick Foundation meets rigorous benchmarks in donor services, investment management, grantmaking, and administration. Merrick Foundation is one of only eight accredited community foundations in Nebraska.

"At Merrick Foundation, a commitment to doing good work right here in Merrick County has always been at the core of what we do," said Shauna Graham. "This accreditation reinforces that commitment and ensures the policies and practices are in place to support long-term financial stability and meaningful community impact."



Earning National Standards accreditation is a comprehensive process requiring detailed review of policies, governance, financial oversight, and operational practices. Documentation is evaluated by an independent community foundation expert through a national review process coordinated by the Community Foundations National Standards Board, a supporting organization of the Council on Foundations.

"The National Standards accreditation affirms that Merrick Foundation is well-positioned to serve both donors and the broader county," said Courtney Retzlaff. "It reflects the care, accountability, and integrity behind this work."

This accreditation reinforces Merrick Foundation's commitment to transparency, stewardship, and lasting community impact—ensuring donors can give with confidence today and for generations to come.

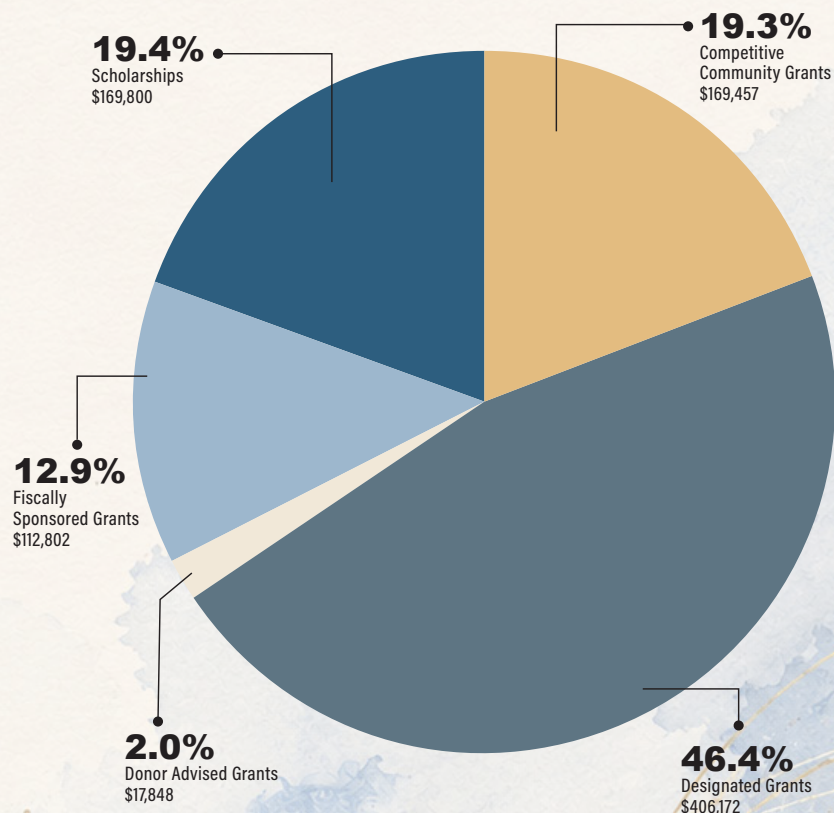

A Gift That Will Last for Generations

One of the most meaningful moments in Merrick Foundation's history came through a transformational legacy gift from Harold & Marjorie Rudolf of Palmer. Their estate gift of \$1,826,114 is the largest gift in the Foundation's 65-year history and will create a lasting impact in Merrick County for generations to come.

Harold, who passed away on September 26, 2024, at the age of 95, lived a life defined by hard work, community involvement, and generosity. Born in Palmer on January 28, 1929, Harold spent much of his life farming alongside his beloved wife, Marjorie Ann Behring, raising hogs and Black Angus cattle until their retirement. Even after retirement, Harold remained connected to the land and continued farming until the age of 85.

A proud U.S. Army veteran who served in Japan and Korea, Harold returned home to Merrick County and built a life centered around family, faith, and community. He remained actively involved throughout the years — serving his church, contributing to the Palmer Farmers Coop Elevator board, and sharing his love of music through choirs, quartets, and solos. Later in life, he discovered a passion for turkey hunting, a hobby that brought him joy well into his 70s.

While Harold and Marjorie did not have children of their own, they shared close relationships with many cousins, nieces, nephews, and extended family members, including a beloved brother-in-law and sister-in-law. They deeply valued friendship and enjoyed countless memories made with friends throughout their lifetime. Harold & Marjorie also had a special love for dogs, owning many over the years and enjoying each one dearly.

In accordance with their wishes, 25% of the bequest will support the Merrick County Historical Museum Endowment, while the remaining 75% will establish the Harold & Marjorie Rudolf Scholarship Endowment Fund. By establishing endowed funds, their impact will continue indefinitely, benefiting both local history and Palmer students for

generations.

The impact of Harold and Marjorie's generosity is already being felt. During the past year, scholarships from the Harold & Marjorie Rudolf Scholarship Endowment Fund totaled \$53,350, contributing to Merrick Foundation awarding a record-breaking \$252,500 in scholarships overall — the highest amount in Foundation history.

Shauna Graham, Chief Development Officer of Merrick Foundation, recalls meeting Harold for the first time in 2019, just two weeks after beginning her role with the Foundation.

"I met with Harold, along with Attorney Andy Hoffman, and we had such a wonderful conversation about how he could truly make a difference in Merrick County," Graham shared. "I still remember him holding our annual report and pointing out how meaningful it was that so many students received

scholarships for college. He was passionate about ensuring that he and Marjorie could create that same kind of impact."

Though Harold and Marjorie are no longer here to see the lives they will touch, their generosity continues to create opportunities for others. Their legacy serves as an inspiring example of how one gift can support students, preserve local history, and strengthen a community far beyond a lifetime.
